Strengthening connections between school & local community.

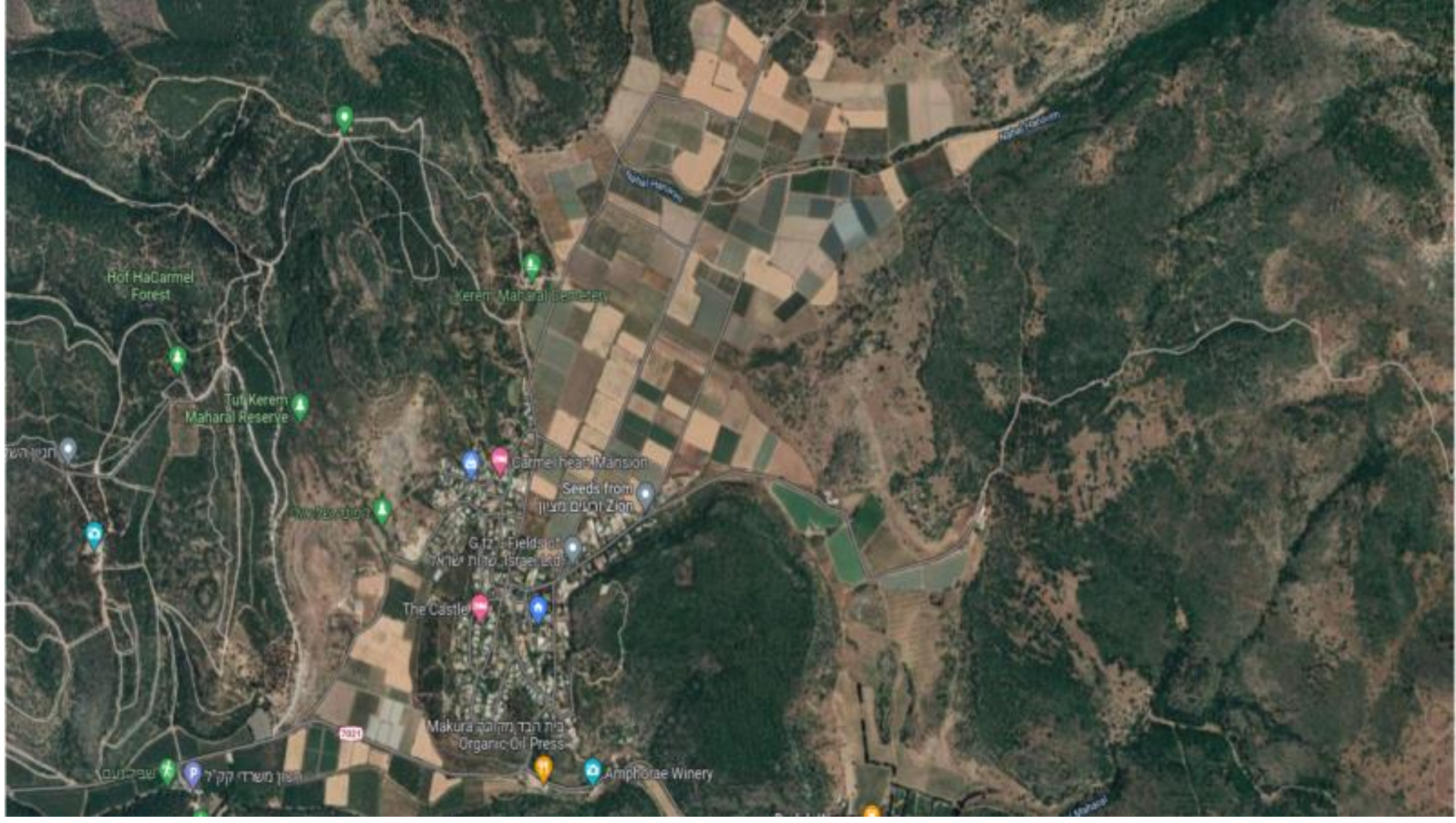


THE PROJECT :
