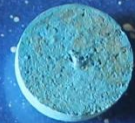

> **Game Rules:**

1. Choose a pawn to taste and to decide who will be the first to play, roll the dice and whoever has the largest number will be 1 and so on.

2. Place the pawn in their "€ 500" (red square) and draw a card belonging to that letter, then choose who will read the question and then answer as well.

3. If you hit, go to the next house and do the same procedure.
If you fail, return to the home of the "500€" and if it is already in this house stays there and give after the turn to the next player.

4. In the game there are 3 helps:

> **Mystery:** Lets you take another card;

> **Dangerous Power:** Keep the house without answering the question and give time to another player;

> **Light:** Use as a last resort. Roll the dice and maybe the numbers 1 and 4, may again choose helps Mystery or Dangerous Power.

This can only be used once as the other.

In the case of not getting any of these n^os at first, there are more opportunities 2 (3 in total). If not handy in any attempt, this aid has no effect.

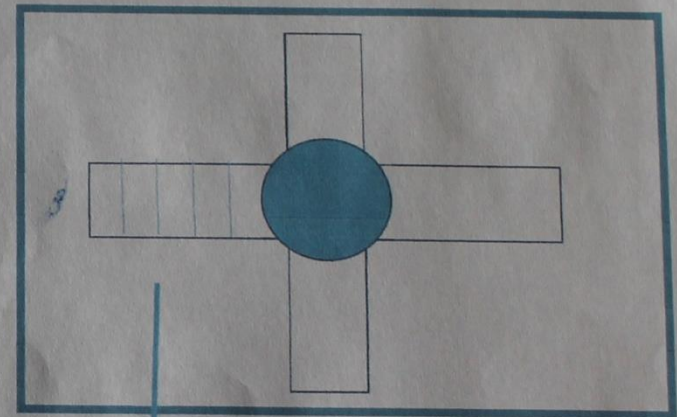
