The game: **Illuminated**

Number of players : 2 – 4

Game rules :

Begins the youngest player, the oldest player is the last.

The players advances the number of squares for each pint of data.

If you stop in a square where already someone, have to go back a square.

What happens if you stop in a special square ?

You have to answer a question that was in a letter, only square salts when you hit reply. A friend of yours will read the question and you will answer, you have got three attempts if you do not hit you stay where you are to turn around and get back your time.

You have to step back three squares.

You have to go back to the beginning and a fresh start.

As you will see is going be a light "on" all the time that you are playing and how to delete unnecessary lights is a good way to end the light pollution, the first to complete the game and "off" the "unnecessary" light will be the winner.

Note:

To win is needed that the number of pints of data is equal to the number of squares to go to the end. If the number is bigger go along to the square and taunting last the rest.
